The recorded or written activist artist's statement (300 words maximum) should describe your piece and how it addresses each of the following: the importance of protecting the Constitution and the rule of law, hopeful action(s) that could be taken, and Minoru Yasui's legacy of seeking justice for all and upholding the rule of law.
